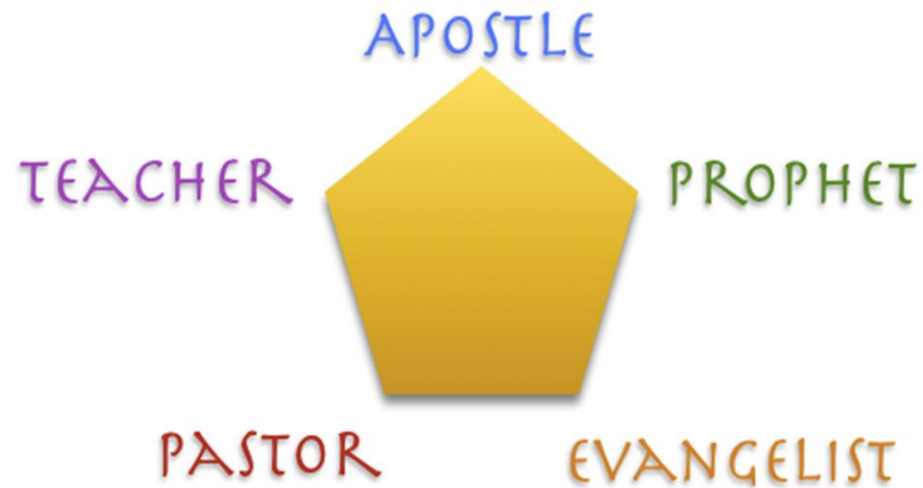

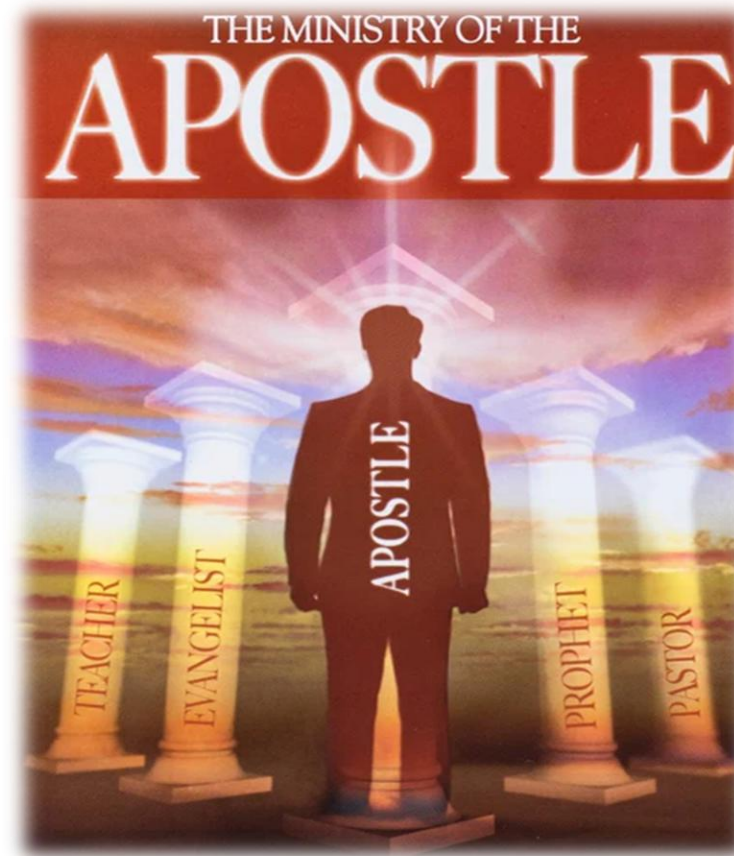

Lesson 1: Ephesians 4:7-16

⁷ But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.

⁸ Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.

⁹ (Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth?

¹⁰ He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.)

¹¹ And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

¹² For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

¹³ Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

¹⁴ That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;

¹⁵ But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:

¹⁶ From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

Lesson 1: Acts 5:12-16

¹² And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch.

¹³ And of the rest durst no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them.

¹⁴ And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.)

¹⁵ Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.

¹⁶ There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

Luke 9:1-5

¹ Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

² And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.

³ And he said unto them, Take nothing for your journey, neither staves, nor scrip, neither bread, neither money; neither have two coats apiece.

⁴ And whatsoever house ye enter into, there abide, and thence depart.

⁵ And whosoever will not receive you, when ye go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a testimony against them.

Lesson 1 - Five-Fold Ministry Given by Jesus Christ: THE MINISTRY of An Apostle Sunday, August 2, 2026

Apostles – sent to proclaim the gospel and establish churches.



What Is an Apostle?

The word apostle didn't originate as a Christian term. In Roman culture, an apostolos (Greek) was often a naval commander, general, or envoy sent to change the culture of a conquered region so it reflected Rome. They didn't just enforce order with swords—they reshaped societies.

That makes it a perfect word for the Kingdom. Apostles are “sent ones”—messengers and ambassadors of Christ sent to bring Kingdom culture into the world.



In Scripture, apostles are:

Ambassadors of the Gospel

Messengers with divine orders

Catalysts for cultural transformation

Servants carrying the authority of God

Summary:

The Scriptures show that the ministry of a prophet is a divine gift (Ephesians 4:11–13, 1 Corinthians 12:4–11), sent to edify the church (Romans 10:13–15), to testify the gospel (Acts 20:24), and to be a humble, faithful example (1 Timothy 4:12, James 4:10).

They are called to endure trials, handle God's word with integrity, and preach with patience and doctrine
