Commentary: Exploring the Four Types of Jesus' Miracles

February – March 2026

We will explore the power and sovereignty of the forty miracles, in “four categories”, that Jesus performed. We will also see how these different miracles come together in a remarkable moment, when John the Baptist asked a haunting question: “Are you the one who is to come, or should we expect someone else?” Jesus’ various miracles were categorized to exhibit the differential issues that plague human nature, because of the fall of man and God’s judgement.

- Category I:** Healing Miracles – The Compassionate King - show his power over the body and his compassion for the broken.
- Category II:** Exorcisms – The Warrior King- show his power over the body and his compassion for the broken.
- Category III:** Nature Miracles – The Creator King- demonstrate his sovereignty over creation
- Category VI:** Restoration Miracles – The Redeeming King- hint at his power over death and his promise of new life.

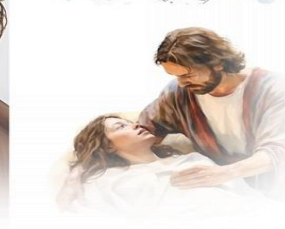

Lesson 3: Luke 8:41-48

⁴¹ And, behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: **and he fell down at Jesus' feet**, and besought him that he would come into his house:

⁴² For he had one only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she lay a dying. But as he went the people thronged him.

⁴³ And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any,

⁴⁴ Came behind him, and touched the border of his garment: and immediately her issue of blood stanchèd.

⁴⁵ And Jesus said, **Who touched me?** When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said, Master, the multitude throng thee and press thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me?

⁴⁶ And Jesus said, **Somebody hath touched me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of me.**

⁴⁷ And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before him, she declared unto him before all the people for what cause she had touched him, and how she was healed immediately.

⁴⁸ And he said unto her, **Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.**

Lesson 3: Luke 8:49-56

⁴⁹ While he yet spake, there cometh one from the ruler of the synagogue's house, saying to him, Thy daughter is dead; trouble not the Master.

⁵⁰ But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, **Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole.**

⁵¹ And when he came into the house, he suffered no man to go in, save Peter, and James, and John, and the father and the mother of the maiden.

⁵² And all wept, and bewailed her: but he said, **Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth.**

⁵³ And they laughed him to scorn, knowing that she was dead.

⁵⁴ And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise.

⁵⁵ And her spirit came again, and she arose straightway: and he commanded to give her meat.

⁵⁶ And her parents were astonished: but he charged them that they should tell no man what was done.
