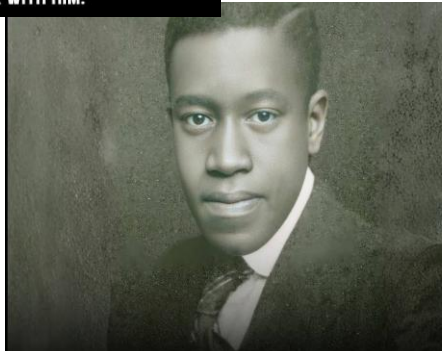

BORN ENSLAVED IN 1860, HIS MOTHER SOLD BEFORE HE WAS BORN. HE DIED A MILLIONAIRE RANCHER IN 1939. WHITE COWBOYS RODE SEGREGATED TRAINS JUST TO SIT AND TALK WITH HIM.



ON SEPTEMBER 26, 1925, ELBERT FRANK COX MADE HISTORY AS THE FIRST BLACK PERSON IN THE UNITED STATES — AND LIKELY THE WORLD — TO EARN A PH.D. IN MATHEMATICS.

Henry Ossian Flipper, the first African American cadet to graduate from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1877. He was also the first Black man to be commissioned in the Army, he led buffalo soldiers of the 10th Cavalry.



Among many firsts, Patricia Bath is the first African American to complete a residency in ophthalmology and the first African-American female doctor to receive a medical patent. She invented the Laserphaco Probe for cataract treatment in 1986.

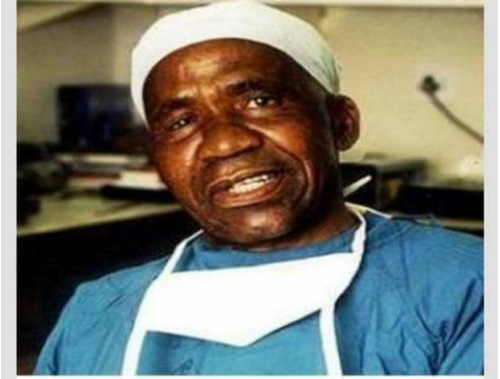

Born 1919

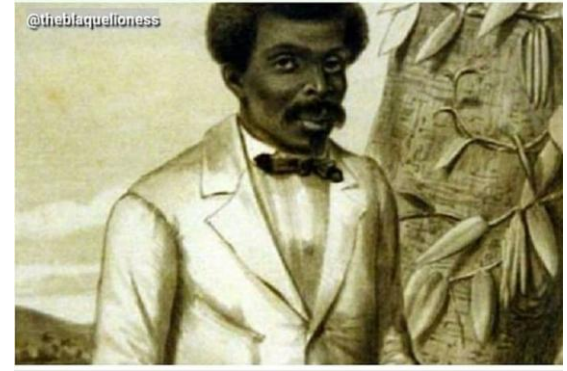


Dr. Jane Wright and her father Dr. Louis T. Wright (1891 ~ 1952) discovered and developed chemicals that attack and destroy cancer cells called chemotherapeutic agents. An effective treatment for most forms of cancer today.



Secret Black Surgeon: Dr. HAMILTON NAKI, 1967 first successful heart transplant, Cape Town. But he could never appear because he was Black. Apartheid a Black man, could not operate on Caucasian patients or touch their blood. White, Chief surgeon, Dr. Christian Barnard, immediately became a celebrity. Hamilton Naki was not allowed to appear on photos with the team.

Edmond Albius was born enslaved in Ste-Suzanne in 1829. His mother died during his birth and his 'master' adopted him. At the age of 12, Albius invented a technique for pollinating the vanilla orchid by hand, launching the vanilla industry.

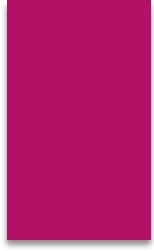
